10.	Consignor understands that the T.A.G.S. Team Member and/or The Consignment Connection are not responsible for any theft, damage, or loss of consigned items.
11.	Consignors using the T.A.G.S. service receive the perks of shopping early at the Consignor presale times stated on our website for the current sale. The Consignor will receive their presale passes at the information desk upon arrival on your presale shopping night.
12.	It is the responsibility of the Consignor to pick up any unsold items at the scheduled pickup time listed for the current event if you have elected not to donate your items to our charity. The tagger is not responsible for picking up your unsold items.
13.	The commission percentages for using this service will be 45% to the Consignor, 20% to the T.A.G.S. Team Member, and 35% to The Consignment Connection. Commission will be paid to each party within two weeks after the close of the current sale you are consigning in.
