The Consignor agrees to the following terms. Please read and sign the last page.

By signing this agreement, Consignor is agreeing to the terms and conditions for The Consignment Connection – Kids Clothing Exchange Consignment Sale, hereafter known as The Consignment Connection.

1. Examine your items carefully for stains, pilling, holes, broken zippers, buttons, low batteries, missing pieces, recalls, et cetera, before meeting your tagger to hand over your items for the current sale. Any items dropped off with the T.A.G.S. Team Member that do not meet the required specifications from our accepted/not accepted list found on our website will be returned to the Consignor unless the consignor requests that those items are being donated and not picked up at the end of the sale.
2. The signed T.A.G.S. Agreement and Consignor Agreement can be emailed to info@theconsignmentconnection.com before the T.A.G.S. Team Member picks up your items, or they can be given to the T.A.G.S. Team Member when your items are picked up. A self-addressed, stamped envelope must also be given to the T.A.G.S. Team Member, which will be used to mail your commission check after the close of the sale.
3. The T.A.G.S. supply fee must be paid to the T.A.G.S. Team Member at the time of pickup. It can be paid in cash or by another preferred payment method of the tagger. For example: Venmo or PayPal. The fee covers supplies the T.A.G.S. Team Member will use while preparing your items for the sale. (See fee chart below.)
4. All clothing items should be freshly laundered and laid in totes or boxes. Fold clothing sets together. Clothing sets must be the same size for tops and bottoms. A sheet of paper with the gender and size must be placed in between categories. Clothing that is freshly laundered and placed on wire hangers with safety pins will receive a \$5 discount on the supply fee. The \$5 discount is only considered if enough hangers and pins are supplied for the entire load.
5. If your items have been stored or if they are being transferred from another sale, it is the consignor's responsibility to thoroughly inspect all of your items to make sure there are no stains, pilling, holes, or foul smells. It is not the tagger's responsibility to inspect and assess the condition of your items before they are tagged for the sale. Our taggers do not have the space to store excess items before the sale. It is the consignor's responsibility to make sure that only quality items are given to the tagger to ensure a successful sale.
6. The T.A.G.S. Team Member and Consignor will meet at a public location that is convenient for both parties. Meetups with the T.A.G.S. Team Member should be completed in one trip. If a Consignor finds more items and a second meetup is needed, a \$15 fee must be paid to the T.A.G.S. Team Member. Your supply fee could also change, depending on how many more items are added to the sale.
7. Note that some categories of items may have quantity limits. Those limits are listed on our website. You must count your items to be sure you have not gone over the item limit before they are given to the tagger. Our taggers do not have the space to store excess items over the item limits.

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8. Your tote(s) will be used for sorting your items for pickup at the end of the sale. Be sure that your Consignor number is clearly visible on your tote(s). All totes must have lids and all boxes must have flaps that close so that the tagger can stack your items for storage prior to the sale.
9. Your T.A.G.S. Team Member will price your items as suggested by you from the T.A.G.S. online form that you submitted when requesting the tagging service. The T.A.G.S. Team Member uses their best judgment and experience and online searches for references.
10. Items will be marked as donated or pickup according to the information on the online form that was submitted when requesting the tagging service.
11. If the Consignor requested to review their prices before tags are printed, the Consignor will be notified and given 24 hours to review the prices and other information in their inventory and make any changes before the tags are printed and placed securely on your items. The Consignor will communicate with the T.A.G.S. Team Member that they are satisfied with the entries and tags can be printed. Once the tags are printed, no changes can be made to your tags. The T.A.G.S. Team Member and/or The Consignment Connection are not responsible if your items do not sell. If the Consignor has not reviewed their prices and communicated with the T.A.G.S. Team Member within 24 hours, the tagger will go ahead and print the tags as entered and attach them to the items and changes cannot be made to the prices.
12. Consignors using the T.A.G.S. service receive the perks of shopping early at the Consignor presale times stated on our website for the current sale.
13. It is the responsibility of the Consignor to pick up any unsold items at the scheduled pickup time listed for the current sale if you have elected not to donate your unsold items after the sale.
14. The commission percentages for using this service are 50% to the Consignor, 20% to the T.A.G.S. Team Member, and 30% to The Consignment Connection. Commission will be paid to each party within two weeks after the close of the current sale you are consigning in.
15. Consignor understands that any unsold items left after the scheduled pickup time for the current sale will become the property of The Consignment Connection.
16. All items left in the possession of the T.A.G.S. Team Member and/or The Consignment Connection are at the sole risk of the Consignor. The Consignor agrees that they will assume and bear all risks regarding items picked up by the T.A.G.S. Team Member and not hold the T.A.G.S. Team Member and/or The Consignment Connection responsible for any and all liability, to include, but not limited to, theft, loss, damage, fire, wind, or rain.
17. I have read and understand all of the consignor and tagging service guidelines and the accepted item list as stated on The Consignment Connection website.

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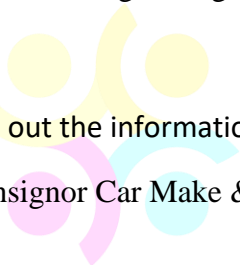
